DESCRIPTION

Cuba is a mosaic of economic, geological, cultural and historical complexity. Explore the capital of this diverse and eclectic country with award winning photographer David Barbour and improve your skills as a creative photographer in one of the most fascinating cities in the world.

This one-week workshop will balance presentations and lectures with specific photo assignments and evening critiques. Each day, students will travel to various locations in the city and concentrate on photographing people and the architecture of the city. A day trip to the East Beaches and Cojimar will be organized mid-week. The goal of this workshop is to challenge participants' experience as photographers with an emphasis on discovering or improving personal vision.

Students are responsible for their own airfare, hotel and insurance. Advice from the instructor is available. The workshop will be organized out of Vedado district where there are a variety of hotels from which to choose.

Students must purchase their own film and have their own manual 35 mm film or digital SLR camera. As this is an intermediate level workshop, participants are expected to have working knowledge of their equipment. Recommended prerequisites are Back to Basics: Film or Foundations in Digital Photography or their equivalent in experience or from another institution. Enrolment is limited to ensure one-on-one attention.
