COURSE DESCRIPTION

In this course we will look beyond photographic technique to discover and reveal the elements and meaning inherent in an image. Employ all your photographic skills to develop an acute visual awareness and understanding of ways to refine your vision and transform an image into a work of fine art.

Subject-specific photo projects and critiques will offer alternate ways to elevate an image beyond the ordinary and develop creativity.

Course content will include: learning from master photographers, painting and photography, critical examination of compositional elements, conveying mood and impact, image content and intent, framing and capture styles, reviewing technical skills, post production workflow from editing to output, printing, archiving, presentation, display, and portfolio design.

***This course will be held offsite at a location to be confirmed upon registration.**

Students must have their own digital SLR camera and laptop computer with Lightroom and/or Photoshop CS, or later, installed. Thirty-day trial versions of software are available. As this is an intermediate level course, participants are expected to have a working knowledge of their equipment and software. Recommended prerequisites are Back to Basics: Film, Foundation in Digital Photography or their equivalent. Enrolment is limited to ensure one-on-one attention.
