## WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Take in the beauty and apply technical skills to capture the essence of the colours of autumn in three local settings. Rideau Hall, Gatineau Park and the Mer Bleue Bog. During the shooting sessions John Hewett Hallum will offer guidance so students may improve their technical skills and learn alternative methods to outdoor nature photography. Particular attention will focus on saturated colours and compositional elements.

An introductory class to review your skills will be followed by a post-production studio session in which students will learn more about composition and enhancing images with basic adjustments prior to output. The workshop will end with a presentation and critique session.

Ability to walk and carry equipment over some uneven trails is required. Transportation to out-of-town locations is the responsibility of the student.

**Students must have their own digital SLR camera and laptop computer with Lightroom and/or Photoshop CS, or later, installed. Thirty-day trial versions of software are available. As this is an intermediate level course, participants are expected to have working knowledge of their equipment and software. Recommended prerequisites are Back to Basics: Film, Foundation in Digital Photography or their equivalent. Enrolment is limited to ensure one-on-one attention.**
