WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Have more images than you can keep track of? Spend less time at the computer and more time shooting. An essential aspect of digital photography is organizing image files for future use and secure storage. Learn to create a personal, efficient and searchable filing system with Adobe Lightroom, the most versatile software currently accessible to photographers.

Through shooting assignments and practical exercises from capture to output, this workshop will teach students how to use Lightroom to organize, refine and output images to the web, slideshow and print.

Students must have their own digital SLR camera and access to a laptop computer with Adobe Lightroom v.2.0. Thirty-day trial versions of software are available. As this is a basic/intermediate level workshop, participants are expected to have a working knowledge of their equipment. Recommended prerequisites are Foundation in Digital Photography, Elementary Photoshop or their equivalent. Enrolment is limited to ensure one-on-one attention.
