WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Get out of the studio! But bring all of the control and style with you. Photographers today can bring to the location portrait more looks than have ever been possible in the past. Learn to control the character of location lighting and manipulate available light with some of the latest portable systems.

To challenge participants, and cover many variables, this two-day exploration will feature professional models, one male and one female, and both interior and exterior environments.

Students must have either a film or digital SLR camera with manual capabilities. They are also encouraged to bring their electronic flash, tripod and laptop if any of these components are part of their gear. Students must purchase their own film and processing and/or digital processing. As this is a basic/intermediate level workshop, working knowledge of camera function is expected. Recommended prerequisites are Back to Basics: Film or Foundation in Digital Photography or their equivalent. Enrolment is limited to ensure one-on-one attention.
