Looking to get the most out of your compact digital camera? This is the workshop for you. John Hewett Hallum will show you how to capitalize on your camera's capabilities.

Understanding the settings and shooting modes on these cameras can sometimes be a daunting task. Flash settings, white balance, ISO, what are these for and how does one get the most out of them? Starting with camera controls and functions, and moving into essential photographic principles, this two-day workshop will provide students the skills to use their cameras more easily and achieve consistently better photographs.

Through lecture and practical exercises, students will learn to solve common problems like red-eye, poor exposure, and loading their pictures onto the computer.

Students must supply their own compact digital cameras. This is a basic level workshop, which teaches fundamentals necessary for some other SPAO courses and workshops. Enrolment is limited to ensure one-on-one attention.
