WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

More images than you can keep track of? An essential aspect of digital photography is organizing image files for future use and secure storage. Learn to create a personal, efficient and searchable filing system using the D.A.M (Digital Asset Management) approach in combination with Adobe Lightroom.

This workshop will teach you how the D.A.M. process is employed after image capture and includes: archiving images, creating a filing system, setting up a searchable data base, making image adjustments in Lightroom, printing and internet output.

Students must have their own digital SLR camera, access to a laptop computer with Adobe Lightroom v.2.0 and an external hard drive (500 GB min). Thirty-day trial versions of software are available to those who do not have Photoshop installed. As this is an intermediate level workshop, participants are expected to have a working knowledge of their equipment. Recommended prerequisites are Foundation in Digital Photography, Elementary Photoshop or their equivalent. Enrollment is limited to ensure one-on-one attention.
