COURSE DESCRIPTION

From public spaces to our own private homes, framed art is everywhere around us. Ever wonder what goes into properly framing a piece of art? Learn why proper framing is necessary for enhancing and beautifying our art, while also preserving and protecting it for generations to enjoy.

In this course, students will learn the basics of framing art, with a special focus on framing photography. Lessons include choosing suitable mats and frames for photos, how to improve already framed pieces, conservation methods of framing, as well as hands-on basic mat cutting and frame assembly. By the end of the course, students will have a working knowledge of the basics of framing, as well as their own framed piece to take home.

No prerequisite experience necessary, knowledge/interest in art preferred.

This course will be held on location at Bank Street Framing, in the Glebe*. Some materials will be included in the tuition fees, but students will be responsible for the cost of framing their own piece, depending on what materials they choose. Enrolment is limited to ensure one-on-one attention.
