## WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Improve your street photography in Montreal with photographer David Barbour. This workshop will emphasize photographing people and urban landscapes in one of Canada's most exciting cities. The workshop will begin and end at SPAO with visual presentations of influential 20th century street photographers. Participants will share transportation via car to Montreal on Saturday, stay overnight and continue photographing on Sunday then return to Ottawa.

The course will concentrate on developing an approach to photographing people in public with regard to ethics and integrating compositional elements in one's work. Throughout the weekend, there will be one-on-one visual exercises with the instructor to improve student's intuition and reaction to which individuals you photograph and how.

Travel, food and accommodation are the responsibility of the student. Carpooling will be arranged. Students must purchase their own film and have their own manual 35 mm film or digital SLR camera. As this is an intermediate level workshop, participants are expected to have working knowledge of their equipment. Recommended prerequisites are Back to Basics: Film or Foundation in Digital Photography or their equivalent. Enrolment is limited to ensure one-on-one attention.
