

**SPAO PORTFOLIO PROGRAM
SPHINX BURSARY 2010/2011**

Award Name: Sphinx Bursary

Description

The Sphinx Bursary 2010/2011 is a \$1,500 bursary available for a selected student of the School of the Photographic Arts: Ottawa (SPAO) Portfolio Program that has successfully graduated from Level 2 Portfolio Development, and has been invited to participate in Level 3 Directed Research and Production and has accepted this offer. This bursary has been established to help a dedicated student of the photographic medium pay their tuition fees for their third year at SPAO pursuing self-directed research and production in the 2010/2011 academic year.

General Information

Both the Luna Bursary and the Sphinx Bursary have been established at SPAO at the request of private donors that are artists and avid practitioners and collectors of photography. They wish to encourage the development of photographic artists by offering financial support to selected students of the SPAO Portfolio Program.

One of each of the Luna Bursary and the Sphinx Bursary will be offered in 2010, to be applied towards tuition for the 2010/2011 academic year.

Applications for the Sphinx Bursary 2010/2011 will be accepted from Monday March 1st, 2010 until Monday March 29th, 2010 at 5:00pm. The recipients of both the Luna Bursary 2010/2011 and the Sphinx Bursary 2010/2011 will be announced Friday April 30th, 2010.

The Sphinx Bursary 2010/2011 has a monetary value of \$1,500.00 and will be paid to the selected recipient by cheque.

Eligibility criteria

To be considered eligible for the Sphinx Bursary, applicants must:

- Be currently enrolled in the SPAO Portfolio Program,
- Be in good academic standing in the SPAO Portfolio Program,
- Have no outstanding financial debt to SPAO,
- Graduate from Level 2 Portfolio Development of the SPAO Portfolio Program, and be invited into in Level 3 Directed Research and Production,
- Accept the offer of transition into Level 3 Directed Research and Production, and
- Submit all required application material for the Sphinx Bursary by the stated deadline.

Selection criteria

- Merit of current work submitted
- Merit of proposed project(s) for the upcoming academic year
- Degree and quality of involvement in and contribution to the SPAO community of the student applying

Conditions of the award

The recipient of the Sphinx Bursary is responsible for and expected to remit by specified deadlines, the balance of his/her tuition fees for Level 3 Directed Research and Production; failure to do so will result in the revocation of the bursary.

Failure to remain in good academic standing in Level 3 Directed Research and Production may result in the revocation of the Sphinx Bursary.

Should the selected recipient of the Sphinx Bursary 2010/2011 be unable or unwilling to continue their studies as proposed in the 2010/2011 academic year, immediate written notification must be given to SPAO to allow the selection of an alternate recipient of the bursary.

Application Process

Eligible current students of Level 2 of the SPAO Portfolio Program, Portfolio Development, must submit their completed application to the designated SPAO officer (Khalia Scott) at the SPAO office, 168 Dalhousie Street, by Monday March 29th, 2010 at 5:00pm:

Enclose with the completed Sphinx Bursary Application Form (see attached appendix A), an Artist's Statement, a proposed Project Description(s) for the 2010/2011 academic year, and 10 digital images on CD. Images must be numbered and correspond to the completed Image List (see attached appendix B) which indicates number, size, media, title, and year of completion.

Guidelines for computer-based electronic files on CD-ROM or DVD: (Please note that the digital support material you provide will be viewed by means of a computer projection system during the selection process.)

Submit digital images. Test your material before you submit it to make sure that it is readable. Each CD-ROM or DVD must be clearly marked with your name. Submit 300 dpi .jpg files only. Label each file (image) with a number and title. Example: 01title.jpg, 02title.jpg, ensure they are presented chronologically and follow your image list. Don't submit any type of presentation (PowerPoint style) or "zipped" or "Stuffit" or other compressed files. Don't include hyperlinks to Internet sites with your images. Don't submit material that requires software, plug-ins, extensions or other executables to be downloaded or installed. Don't submit any files by e-mail, Don't submit any other component of your application electronically on your CD-ROM or on your DVD.

Students submitting support material that does not correspond to the guidelines will be refused and made ineligible for the bursary.

Completed applications can be dropped off at the SPAO office, 168 Dalhousie Street, Ottawa.
Only complete applications received by the deadline will be accepted.

Selection Process

The date of selection of the recipient of the Sphinx Bursary is to be determined.

Applications will be assessed by a peer assessment committee composed of experienced professionals and representation by the donors of the Sphinx Bursary funds.

Jury member decisions will be based on:

- the quality of the examples of current work and the supporting Artist's Statement,
- the quality of proposed project(s) for the upcoming academic year, and
- the degree and quality of involvement in and contribution to the SPAO community of the student applying

The recipients of both the Luna Bursary 2010/2011 and the Sphinx Bursary 2010/2011 will be announced at the School of the Photographic Arts: Ottawa graduation ceremony Friday April 30th, 2010.

Awarding of Scholarships and Prizes at SPAO

A student may be awarded more than one donor funded scholarship or bursary if the total value of the scholarship/s or bursary/s awarded in any one year is less than \$6,500. If a student is awarded a scholarship with a value of \$13,000 or more, then the recipient will not normally be eligible for any other donor funded scholarship during their undergraduate study at SPAO. Exceptions may apply. Prizes are awarded on the basis of academic merit and there is no limit to the number awarded to an individual student in an academic year.

Definitions

'Scholarship' – for the purposes of this document, 'scholarship' means any scholarship, bursary or other type of award, which has a monetary value over \$500.00.

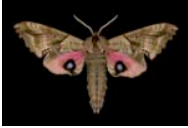
'Bursary' – for the purposes of this document, 'bursary' means a monetary award to SPAO students that allows them to continue their studies.

'Prizes' – prizes in these procedures refer to prizes for academic achievement and therefore exclude competition prizes.

'Endowed funds' – are funds that are invested to provide income in perpetuity. Each year a portion of the income generated from the principal is released to be used for the specific purpose for which the fund was established.

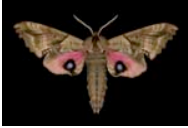

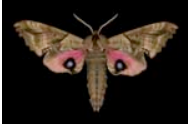
