LEVEL: BASIC/INTERMEDIATE

WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Be introduced to the creative potential of the flash with this exciting new workshop featuring professional photographer, Adrien Duey. This hands-on workshop will have students shooting all weekend long, both in the studio and on location. Students will work in teams to mix flash with a variety of ambient light scenarios.

ON-CAMERA FLASH: Students will create and manage subtle fill lighting to achieve balanced light portraits and explore over and under exposure techniques that will open up a world of possibilities in everyday photography.

OFF-CAMERA FLASH: Create dramatic portrait lighting by blending ambient light and off-camera flash. Topics covered in this section will include camera and flash communication, light modification (filters, diffusion), color temperature, light stands and simple booms, and single and multiple flash units.

An SLR or DSLR camera with flash is required. Students must purchase their own film and processing and/or digital processing. As this is a basic/intermediate level lighting workshop, working knowledge of camera function is expected. Students are also encouraged to bring their electronic flash, tripod and laptops if any of these components are part of their gear. Recommended prerequisites are Back to Basics: Film, or Foundation in Digital Photography or their equivalent. Enrolment is limited to ensure one-on-one attention.
